Acoustic and disinfectable partitions in all studios between dubbing director & sound engineer as well as voice actor & audio editor.



Disinfection dispensers throughout facility as well as outside main entrances.



Only one voice actor recorded at a time.
Strict disinfection routines throughout the facility and in studios between every single voice actor.

Re. Workplace inspection regarding Covid-19 safety measures

Together with members of your team, we conducted a workplace inspection on your company premises on April1. The aim was to check whether the protective measures you are considering or have already implemented against infection by Covid-19 are sufficient or may need to be extended or supplemented further.

The entrance and waiting area, the common facilities, the sound studios and the offices were inspected and assessed. Safety measures by marking minimum distances, erection of partition walls, use of surface disinfection and, if necessary, disposable gloves, repositioning of furniture and organizational adaptation of work processes were defined and established as measures. Furthermore, we discussed possible procedures in case of unclear symptoms of employees.

In my opinion, the measures taken in this way fully comply with the current recommendations about safety standards at work during the current SARS-CoV-2 pandemic as published by the Ministry for Work and Social Affairs on 16 April 2020.
